NOTES

1. The daily schedule of language programmes includes daily 2 hours of **language instruction**, 2 hours of **language workshop** (language games, communication activities, presentations and lectures by Greek intellectuals, writers, artists, local politicians, and everyday people), and two hours of **educational and cultural activities** (presentations on history, the arts and society, Greek dance lesson, Greek cookery class, singing lesson, Greek film, cultural walks and visits).

2. The daily schedule of **European Cultural Identity and Greece** includes outdoor activities in museums, archaeological sites, artists' ateliers, accompanied by experts and audiovisual presentations

3. In the **Languages United: Greek and Turkish Tandem** programme the language instruction is either in Greek or in Turkish.

4. In the **Ancient Greek** programme the language workshop includes practice in translation, getting to know the writers and the history and introduction to Modern Greek.

5. In the **Languages United: Greek and Turkish Tandem** programme the language workshop is the Greek-Turkish Tandem.

6. Only one and two-week programmes are available at the start date 27/8/2012.

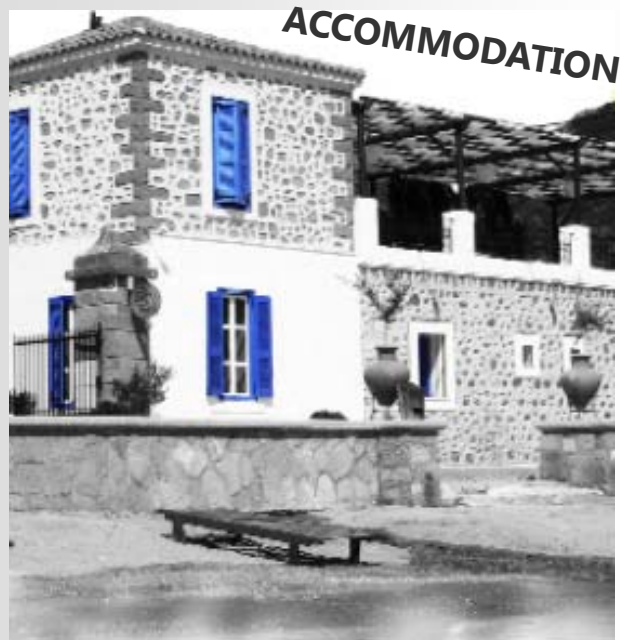

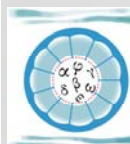
